A Message from Pastor Andrea

I've seen much social commentary naming that January felt like it was 347 days long. I completely agree, and I'm grateful February has (finally) arrived. As we look forward into February (and into March), I am excited for the things that are coming up here at Dayspring.

On February 14, while some people may be celebrating with roses and dinners and valentines, we'll be honoring Ash Wednesday—a day that some Christians have called "the most honest day of the year." This day marks the season of Lent: the 40 days (not including Sundays) that lead up to Easter, reminisicent of Jesus' forty days in the wilderness.

Lent, and Ash Wednesday especially, are moments in our year where we intentionally pause to remember who and whose we are:

We remember that we were made from dust; we remember that we are fleeting, but our God is not. This is a humbling remembrance.

We remember that we sin, falling short of the wholeness for which we were created. We take a moment to name this before God (and each other), accepting the forgiveness and salvation that Christ brings to us all.


We mark these remembrances with ashes on our foreheads—ashes that come from last year's Palm Sunday palms.

This year, we are offering two Ash Wednesday services, both of which will take place in the chapel: one at 12 pm and one at 6 pm. Both services will be short (no longer than 30 minutes), and we hope you'll be able to attend one of them.

I'm also excited because February 18 is the first Sunday of the season of Lent, and we'll be honoring this season through prayers, confessions, and weekly communion. We'll also be talking about different theories of the cross of Christ—different Atonement Theories—as we make our way toward Good Friday and Easter Sunday.

Note: our Sunday night Adult Bible Study will be starting back up on February 25, and we'll discuss these theories more in depth during that time as well.

My prayer is that this season of Lent will be meaningful and sacred for all of us here at Dayspring, and that we will be overcome by the width, depth, height, and length of God's love for us and for this world. What a joy it will be to celebrate this season with all of you!


Red Cross Community Blood Drive, March 5 from noon-4pm
